# Goals

Holy Trinity Preschool seeks to:

- ~ Provide developmentally appropriate academic readiness activities that foster intellectual growth.
- ~ Provide fine and large muscle activities to increase physical well being.
- ~ Provide a supportive play environment in which children can begin to learn appropriate social skills.
- ~ Provide the opportunity for spiritual growth through song, prayer and sharing.
- ~ Provide the opportunity for creativity through artistic choice time and dramatic play.

#### **Admission**

Applications are accepted for children 3 - 5 years of age.

Children must be 3 years old as of August 31<sup>st</sup> and be toilet trained to attend.

The following forms must be completed:

Immunizations - a copy of the child's records must be on file before school starts.

**Student Registration form -** A registration fee of \$45.00 is payable when the application for enrollment is submitted. This fee must be paid each year.

Children will be admitted without regard to race, color, and national or ethnic origin.

Children with special needs requiring support beyond the scope of our program will be referred to programs that can provide additional special help.

#### **Tuition**

The tuition is divided into 9 monthly payments and should be <u>paid no later than the  $7^{th}$  of each month</u>. Checks should be made out to Holy Trinity Preschool and should have your child's name on the check. You may also make payments directly on our website.

\$288.00 part-time

# Policy on Prompt Payment

Families are expected to make their payments by the  $7^{th}$  of the month. (Annual or quarterly payments are also acceptable). A payment not received by the  $7^{th}$  of the month is deemed to be late (assuming no alternate arrangement has been made with the church office).

The following steps may be taken for delinquent account:

A \$10 late fee with be assessed.

Children may be excluded from school if their accounts are more than one month delinquent and their families have failed to contact the church office to establish a payment plan or apply for a scholarship. When the family's account is up to date, a payment plan is agreed upon and a partial payment is made, or a scholarship has been granted, the child may return to school.

#### Scholarships/Financial Aid

Scholarships (partial financial aid) are provided on a first-come, first-serve basis without regard of race, color and national or ethnic origin. A Scholarship Application form must be filled out and brought before the board for consideration. If your financial capabilities change, please let the office know. Thank you!

Please call the preschool / church office 452-2323 if your child will be absent. Leave a message if no one answers the phone. Current phone numbers for parents (home and work) and emergency contacts must be left on file with the preschool staff.

# Injury

In case of serious emergency - 911 will be notified and your child's welfare will be our first priority. Immediately thereafter, parents will be notified.

# Arrival / Dismissal

Attendance at preschool should be a regularly scheduled event. Please bring and pick up your child on time.

Arrival: 8:00 AM Dismissal: 12:00 PM

We are unable to release your child to anyone who is not on the permission list.

#### Calendar

Holy Trinity Preschool follows the Port Angeles Public Schools calendar, with the exception of the first and last day of school. A parent meeting will be held prior to the beginning of school.

#### Weather

When public schools are closed, Holy Trinity Preschool will be closed. If public schools are on a two-hour late start, preschool will begin at 9:30 AM. Announcement will be made on the radio channel Radio Pacific (KONP) AM 1450.

#### Snack

All children will participate in a collective snack time, with snacks provided by enrolled families. A schedule will come out monthly designating days for families to bring snacks.

8:30 - 8:55 table time

9:00 - 9:30 group time
9:30 - 9:50 outside time
9:50 - 10:25 choice time: selected individual activities, math, science, blocks housekeeping, trains, books, etc.

10:25 - 10:30 clean-up

10:30 - 10:40 Jesus time

10:40 - 10:55 snack

10:55 - 11:00 closing circle

#### **Discipline**

We believe in positive reinforcement. We give children attention for appropriate behaviors and attempt to redirect children to a new task or activity when they are being inappropriate. If a child loses self control he or she will be removed from the group and one of the teachers will stay with the child until he or she is calm.

#### Parent Communication

If you have a question or a concern, you may talk to the preschool teacher after class or call the church between 11:00 AM and noon. Please check your child's cubby daily.

Parents will receive a monthly calendar, and newsletter

Parents may request a conference with the teacher to discuss Kindergarten readiness or any other concern at any time.

Teachers will be scheduling mandatory teacher/parent/child meeting before school begins

# <u>Preschool Board</u>

Approximately once a month the preschool board meets, to talk about current preschool issues, fundraiser ideas, and anything else that is important in the preschool community. A great way to be a part of your child's preschool experience is to join the board. Drop ins welcome. If interested contact the teachers.

# **Clothing**

Please dress your child in clothes and shoes that allow him or her to play safely and use the bathroom independently. Keep a spare set of clothes in the backpack in case of accidents and spills. Please mark your child's coat, hat and backpack.

## **Parties**

We have five class parties during the school year: Halloween, Thanksgiving, Christmas, Valentine's Day, Easter.

## Special Events

Fundraisers help us keep the cost of tuition down. Parents and children are encouraged to attend and volunteer if able. Other family members are also welcome.

Our current fundraisers are: a spaghetti dinner in the fall, and we will be providing more fundraisers throughout the school year. We're open to new ideas & volunteers!
