Welcome! We are happy that you are worshipping with us.

It is the purpose of Lutheran worship to assure you of God's love and forgiveness, and to provide the experience of Christ who will be with us in, under and with the sacrament of Holy Communion.

We are not God's gatekeepers and so we exercise Eucharistic hospitality, which means that all who feel called to participate in the sacrament of Holy Communion are invited to do so.

Grape juice (white) and gluten free bread are available. Wine is served in the common cup and in individual cups.

We welcome children in worship. We know that they can be noisy at times. Do NOT worry about that! Most of us have children, too, and we know how children are. We value the presence of your children in worship more than we value silence in the pews. Nursery Care is available for children under five, if you so choose.

You decide if you want us to commune your children. Maybe they do not fully understand the theology of Holy Communion, but they

understand very well that something beautiful and important is going on. As alternative, we can also bless them.

You can dress however you like, but please go light on fragrances. Some people can have allergic reactions to scents.

All are welcome here. And by all we mean everybody, no conditions. God loves you no matter what, and we try our best to do likewise.

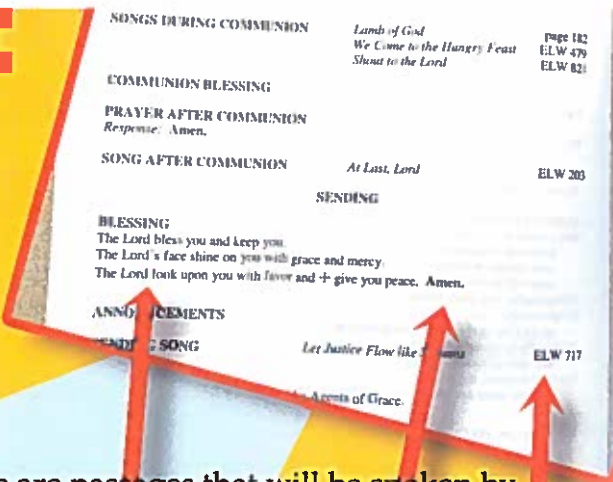

What you need to participate in worship is the **HYMNAL** and the **BULLETIN**.

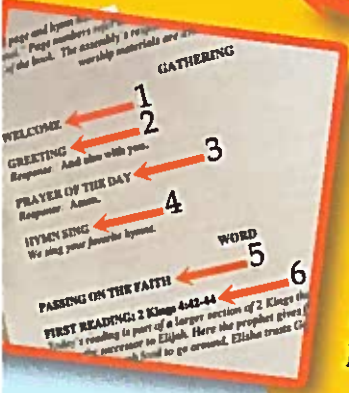


There are passages that will be spoken by the **worship leaders**. Sometimes the congregation is invited to **respond**. You will find the words for the responses in your bulletin. **They are printed in bold letters.**

You are invited to **participate in communion.**



In preparation for the Lord's Supper, we shake each other's hand to extend the Peace of the Lord to each other.



Worship in our congregation is liturgical, which means it has an order in which things are happening.

The congregation joins together in song. The **hymnal** is the red book that you will find in front of you. Each hymn we sing has a **number**.

At the direction of the ushers come forward. You can kneel or not. When you receive the bread and wine (white liquid is grape juice) respond with ...



AMEN!

The bulletin is a guide that lists the sequence of events. One bold and capitalized **HEADLINE** marks each event.

For some events we will be standing up and for others we will be sitting down. Just follow the announcements of the worship leaders. Please stand up only when you are able to do so comfortably.



The worship leaders announce hymn numbers, they are printed in your **bulletin** and they are also on the big boards in the front. ELW means red book.

Sometimes the bulletin asks you to turn to a **page number** in the red book e.g. p. 182
